Job Description: The Associate Teacher/Family Health Advocate's responsibilities continue outside the classroom with home visits with MCCC families. Plan, teach, and implement classroom activities. Develop and use integrated daily lesson plans to meet children's individualized goals and the Federal Head Start Performance Standards. Monitor/supervise children at all times to ensure safety. Create and change learning centers to support learning goals

Job Requirements: Head Start teachers require Associate's or Bachelor's degree in Early Childhood Education or Associate's or Bachelor's degree with six college courses in child development or early childhood education, focusing on children ages birth to five. Ability to pass and maintain a criminal background check meeting State, Federal &/or local guidelines for working with children. Current Infant/Child CPR and First Aid certifications and Food Handler's Permit within 30-days of hire. Two years experience working directly with young infants, toddlers and/or children preferred.

MCCC will provide and pay for all mandatory certifications and trainings.
