Job Description: The Health, Nutrition, and Safety Manager ensures that children and families are receiving comprehensive services that promote health, safety, and nutrition. The incumbent ensures that all aspects of the health, nutrition and safety components meet or exceed Head Start Performance Standards along with other applicable standards, such as the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP).

Job Requirements: Bachelor's degree in Public Health, health administration, nursing, health education or closely related field preferred. Two to five years of experience and training in public health, nursing, health education, maternal and child health, or health administration. Three to five years management and/or supervisory experience. Ability to pass and maintain a criminal background check meeting State, Federal &/or local guidelines for working with children. Current Infant/Child CPR and First Aid certifications and Food Handler's Permit within 30-days of hire. MCCC will provide training and pay for all mandatory certifications and trainings.
