**Job Description**: The Education Disability Coordinator supervises the delivery of Education and Disabilities services in assigned centers, as outlined in the Work Plans. Monitors and tracks services provided through direct observation in classrooms and through oversight of on-going assessment, lesson planning and individualizing using the program software system. Assists in assessment, planning and evaluation of education/disabilities component goals. Completes required monitoring and other reports. Aids teachers in development of curriculum, implementing education activities and integrating Individual Education Plan/Individual Family Service Plan goals into the curriculum.

**Job Requirements:** Bachelor's degree in Early Childhood Education; or Bachelor's degree with six college courses in child development or early childhood education, focusing on children ages birth to five. (Diploma will be required to validate ECE degree and/or transcripts to validate six related classes.) Two to four years' experience teaching preschool-age children. Must have a valid drivers license and pass a criminal background check.
