Job Description: **Operates 24 passenger class C "short" bus** transporting preschool children to assigned centers, to and from home in a safe manner. Ensures that highest possible safety standards are followed in the operation and maintenance of the assigned vehicle. Follows all state, local and organizational requirements. **Works in coordination with a second MCCC staff monitoring children riding the bus.**

Job Requirements: High school diploma or equivalent. Current or ability to obtain Commercial Driver's License (CDL) with School Bus (S) and Passenger (P) endorsements required or the ability to obtain and maintain S & P CDL endorsements. Must complete First Aid/CPR and Food Handlers certifications within 30 days of hire. Must be able to pass drug testing requirements as governed by the DOT regulations, which includes enrollment in MCCC's random drug/alcohol testing program. Current driver's license with 3 year driving history, insurance, and access to a reliable car during working hours. Pass a criminal background check meeting State, Federal and/or local requirements.
